How to Pack & Transport Your Items Safely:

- 1. Pack containers in a sturdy box or tub with newspaper or other absorbent material.
- 2. Do not mix materials. Keep incompatible materials separate (i.e. bleach separate from ammonia).
- 3. Use containers that do not leak. Make sure lids are on tight and contents are labeled.
- 4. Limit toxic items to 15 flowing liquid gallons or 125 pounds per trip. (CA State Law). No container larger than 5 gallons.
- 5. Transport wastes in the trunk or rear of your vehicle.
- 6. You may make as many trips as needed.
