How to Pack & Transport Your Items Safely:

1. Pack containers in a sturdy box or tub with newspaper or other absorbent material.
2. Do not mix materials. Keep incompatible materials separate (i.e. bleach separate from ammonia).
3. Use containers that do not leak. Make sure lids are on tight and contents are labeled.
4. Limit toxic items to 15 flowing liquid gallons or 125 pounds per trip. (CA State Law). No container larger than 5 gallons.
5. Transport wastes in the trunk or rear of your vehicle.
6. You may make as many trips as needed.
